“WORLD HABITAT DAY” IS OCTOBER 5th

SOUTHEAST NH — SENH Habitat for Humanity is celebrating “World Habitat Day” with a special ribbon cutting ceremony to announce their newest build projects in Rochester, NH.

The event will take place Monday October 5th at eleven-am, at 10 Glen Street in Rochester. This celebration marks Habitat’s first-ever Veteran build. This will be 2 new homes and will be built with the help of veteran volunteers. Additionally Habitat’s goal is to partner with a deserving local veteran family in making homeownership a reality.

Habitat for Humanity, a non-profit organization, is dedicated to building affordable housing to help those in need in Strafford County and Rockingham County. The organization partners with deserving families and offers new and rehabbed homes with zero percent interest mortgages. Partner families help to build their own homes and others homes by engaging in sweat equity hours and continued partnering with Habitat.

Habitat has served Southeast New Hampshire for over twenty years and volunteers have built and rehabbed more than 25 affordable homes in the community. Currently building in Strafford County they are also searching for suitable land parcels in Rockingham County. They offer Corporate Builds and Team Builds of all sizes. In addition to construction related tasks, Habitat holds fundraising events, manages partner family mortgages and strives to work with volunteers, contributors and communities all with the vision for affordable and safe housing solutions.

In addition to building safe, decent, affordable homes, SENH Habitat for Humanity operates the ReStore - a retail outlet for building materials, furniture and home goods. All of the profit from ReStore sales are invested back into Habitat building projects. The ReStore is located at 29 Fox Run Road in Newington (the former Happy Wheels roller rink).
