Transition Metals Recycling, LLC Partners with Southeast New Hampshire Habitat for Humanity in Unique Fundraising Program

Support Habitat for Humanity through Recycling

Dover, NH - August 24, 2015 – Transition Metals Recycling, LLC (TMR) announced today that it has partnered with Southeast New Hampshire Habit for Humanity (Habitat) to establish a fundraising program where Seacoast area residents and businesses may turn their recycling efforts into funding to support Habitat’s vision where everyone has a safe and decent place to live, and poverty housing and homelessness are eliminated for low-income families in the area.

Beginning today, members of the Seacoast community may donate common items such as aluminum cans, old copper pipe and electrical wiring, old aluminum siding, gutters and downspouts, brass fixtures and fittings, and auto/boat/rv batteries to Habitat by simply bringing them to TMR’s Dover facility. TMR will purchase the items at current scrap market pricing, transferring all of the proceeds to Habitat.

“We are grateful for organizations like Transition Metals to provide alternative fundraising efforts such as this,” said Marcie Bergen, executive director of SE NH Habitat for Humanity. “With so many organizations asking for money these days, this is a great opportunity for individuals to support us through an everyday activity.”

To kick things off, during the month of September TMR will donate an additional \$0.05/lb. for all non-ferrous metal purchases through this program, and its everyday recyclers to Habitat.
